### DOG LICENSE:

All dog owners must license their dogs every year.

License fees are as follows:

Male or Female \$8.00

Neutered or Spayed \$3.00

**Kennel (6 to 12 dogs) \$35.00\*\*\***

Mail Rabies Certificate of Vaccination which a Veterinarian must perform (and will be returned to you) and the license fee (separate from TAX payment) to Pearl Schicker  
 Town of Metomen, Treasurer

Rabies Vaccination Certificate is Required by Law to issue License.

### **\*\*\*UPDATED KENNEL DOG LICENSE ORDINANCE:**

**You must get Town Board approval to obtain your kennel license at a monthly town board meeting. A Kennel License is required for 6-12 dogs on site.**

**\*\*\*BUILDING PERMITS \*\*\*** A land use permit is required for all new buildings (including Agricultural buildings), remodeling, etc. If you need a permit or are unsure if you need a permit for work being done: Call Town Chairman, Jeff Amend- 920-428-5390 for more information. Forms are available in the town hall entrance.

**Before ditching, draining, or tilling any lands that may be zoned wetland by County Ordinance, contact your Town Board.**

**FARMLAND PRESERVATION INFORMATION** – All participants will need to meet all of the Agriculture Performance Standards, complete a Certificate of Compliance and then have it signed by the Land and Water Conservation Department by the end 2017. Contact the Land and Water Conservation Dept at 920/923-3033 ext. 3 for details.

**POWTS Special Assessment:** Pursuant to Resolution Number 124-09, adopted by the Fond du Lac County Board of Supervisors on March 16, 2010, and effective on the 2017 property tax bill, Fond du Lac County will apply a special assessment fee of \$7.00 for each Private Onsite Wastewater Treatment System (POWTS) in Fond du Lac County. This annual fee is designed to cover the costs of information collection and administration of the POWTS program. If you are a tax-exempt organization (i.e. church or governmental unit), you will still receive the charge of \$7.00 per POWTS since this is a special assessment, not a tax. If you feel this information is in error, please call the Fond du Lac County Code Enforcement Office at 920-929-3139. Please leave your name, address of the property, phone number, and why you feel this assessment is in error.
